LET'S START

- + What animal are you most afraid of?
- + Have you ever seen a lion or any other large wild animal in person? How did that experience make you feel?

LET'S TALK

- + Would you consider yourself a lifelong learner? In what areas do you continue to learn?
- + Daniel was known for his character and integrity. What other places in God's word do we see the importance of being set apart?
- + Read [Daniel 6:7](#). What would you do if you were Daniel? How far are you willing to go for your faith?
- + What connection is there between prayer and faith?

LET'S ACT

- + Give some examples where your faith was testing in our culture. How did you face it?
- + The circumstances did not change Daniel's relationship with God. List some areas in your relationship with God you want to be unwavering in on a sheet of paper.
- + Donald Whitney states, "No matter how weak or strong your prayer life is right now, you can learn to grow even stronger". Take some time to personally reflect on your prayer life. Start by asking yourself if you would consider your prayer life "hot" or "cold" ([Revelations 3:15](#) - do not choose somewhere in the middle). To begin, use your list you wrote in the question above. What steps do you need to take to grow in those areas of your life?
 - Learn about it (example in Bible)
 - Set apart a time and place
 - Find a spiritual mentor
 - Pray about what to pray about
 - Keep a prayer journal
